## **Notice on privacy**

In the following, we would like to inform you that at Milan-Spiele, personal data is requested from you and this is stored electronically.

Personal data is the information that enables a person to be identified. This includes in particular name, date of birth, address and telephone number.

Your personal data will only be stored within the company Milan-Spiele and will be used to manage your customer account, to carry out your orders and all related processes. A transfer to third parties takes place to the extent that this is necessary for the execution of your orders, for example to employees of the company Milan-Spiele and commissioned transport companies. It will only be passed on to other people if Milan-Spiele is legally obliged to do so. This applies to authorities, for example. In addition, we will under no circumstances pass on your personal data to third parties for commercial or non-commercial purposes.

To use our online offers, you need to register; your browser must accept cookies for this. A cookie assigns you an identity number and remembers which items you have placed in the shopping cart. No further data is stored in the cookies.

Of course, you can have your electronically stored data deleted at any time by sending a short, written request by letter or e-mail, provided that they do not have to be kept for legal reasons (accounting obligations, tax law).

A newsletter will not be sent to you automatically, but only if you expressly consent to it being sent.

Use of Facebook plugins This website uses plugins from the social network facebook.com, which is operated by Facebook Inc., 1601 S. California Ave, Palo Alto, CA 94304, USA ("Facebook"). When you visit our website with such a plugin, a connection to the Facebook servers is established and the plugin is displayed on the website by a message to your browser. This will tell the Facebook server which of our websites you have visited. If you are logged in as a member of Facebook, Facebook will assign this information to your personal Facebook user account. When using the plug-in functions (e.g. clicking the "Like" button, submitting a comment), this information is also assigned to your Facebook account, which you can only prevent by logging out before using the plug-in.
